FRANCE

Brasserie Maddam

Chablis, Burgundy

Cousins Alexis and Vianney set up shop in the heart of Chablis wine country to make something different: organic, unfiltered, unpasteurized craft beer with real terroir character. Proof that Burgundy's obsession with place isn't limited to the grape.

Champagne Guy Dumangin

Chigny-les-Roses, Montagne de Reims

Thirteen generations deep, this Premier Cru grower-house does everything in-house: pressing, blending, disgorging right down to the gram. Chalk-soil precision from a family that's never known any other trade.

Champagne Valérie et Gaël Dupont

Marne

Two winegrowing families, ten villages, six soil types. Valérie and Gaël turned generations of grape-growing into their own house in 2019, now certified organic. Each cuvée is a mosaic of Champagne's lesser-known corners, made with real agro-ecological conviction.

Château Chauvin

Saint-Émilion Grand Cru Classé, Bordeaux

Classified since 1955 and now guided by Sylvie Cazes of Lynch-Bages fame, Chauvin sits on rare iron-rich, sandy-clay soil bordering Pomerol. The result: Merlot-driven Saint-Émilion of real elegance, precision, and quiet confidence.

Domaine Burgaud

Ampuis, Côte-Rôtie

Three generations deep in the heart of

Côte-Rôtie, the Burgaud family has spent decades reviving abandoned hillside plots into some of the appellation's finest Syrah. One blend, one vintage, no shortcuts. Just old vines, steep granite slopes, and a family renowned for prioritizing quality over expansion.

Domaine JC Bersan

Saint-Bris-le-Vineux, Burgundy

A rare Burgundian estate growing six grape varieties across Chablis, Saint-Bris, and Irancy including Sauvignon Blanc, uncommon this far north. Organic since 2012 and aged in 12th-century vaulted cellars, Bersan's wines are sincere, structured, and deeply of their soil.

Domaine Monin

Bugey, Savoie

Bugey is one of France's oldest wine regions, farmed since the Gauls and later prized by medieval monks. Owner Charles Varin-Bernier, also a master cheesemaker by trade, has spent a decade reviving this 8.5-hectare estate, including two hectares of Grand Cru Manicle, a clifftop plot once tended by the 19th-century gastronome Brillat-Savarin. Organic-certified as of 2023, these are wines of real alpine character from a region finally getting its due.

Le Clos de la Meslerie

Vouvray, Loire Valley

Peter Hahn traded a career in finance for four hectares of old-vine Chenin Blanc and a century-old basket press. The result is Vouvray at its most contemplative: slow-fermented, hand-worked, and utterly true to place.

ITALY

Casaccia di Franceschi

Sant'Angelo in Colle, Montalcino

Siblings Flavia and Federico Franceschi are the sixth generation of a Montalcino winegrowing family, but this estate, carved from reclaimed truffle ground 500 meters up, is entirely their own. Young hands, old roots, and Brunello already turning heads.

Casaloste

Panzano, Chianti Classico

"The small farm of great wines." Giovanni and Emilia d'Orsi left Naples for these Panzano hillsides in 1992 and never looked back, farming organically since day one. Their Sangiovese carries real Tuscan grit with spice, structure, and Neapolitan soul stamped right on the label.

Cascina Bongiovanni

Castiglione Falletto, Barolo

Family-run since 1950 and named for its founder, this Barolo estate farms 7 hectares in one of the appellation's most coveted communes. Ecologically minded, hands-on, and built on three generations of doing things the honest way.

Gambino Vini

Mount Etna, Sicily

Vineyards at 800 meters on an active volcano, a cellar dug ten meters into lava rock. Gambino makes wine the way Etna demands, patiently, sustainably, and with real reverence for a landscape unlike anywhere else on earth.

Sutto Family (et al)

Veneto

Since 1933, three generations of the Sutto family have farmed the Piave, Valdobbiadene, and Collio. A rare range across Prosecco's home turf and beyond. Three distinct labels, one unwavering commitment to place and quality.

NEW ZEALAND

Parallel Universe

Marlborough

A new venture from Ruud Maasdam, one of New Zealand's most respected and decorated winemakers, with decades of hands-on experience crafting Marlborough's benchmark Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir, and Chardonnay. Parallel Universe is Ruud unbound with a fresh label built on the same meticulous, small-batch craftsmanship that earned him his reputation, now poured entirely on his own terms.

SPAIN

Pinord

Penedès, Catalonia

Four generations of the Tetas family, 150 years of winemaking, and the house that made Spain's first sparkling wine back in the 1940s. Pinord champions native Xarel·lo, Macabeo, and Parellada from vineyards farmed organically at the source.

TURKEY

Kavaklıdere Wines / Maison Kavaklıdere

Anatolia & Bordeaux, France

Founded in 1929, Kavaklıdere is Turkey's first private winery, championing indigenous Anatolian grapes like Kalecik Karası, Emir, and Öküzgözü across four generations. We work directly with Aslı Başman, the family's fourth generation and the driving force bridging Kavaklıdere's Anatolian roots with Maison Kavaklıdere, its estate in Bordeaux's Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux. This is a rare chance to taste one family's terroir philosophy across two very different corners of the wine world.
